A Wet Spring...

The snowmobiling part of our season, in my opinion, officially ends on Sunday, April 15, 2007. As of this date, we are required to have all of our trail signs removed so our landowners can start working their fields. The drawback this spring has been the rain, and as you have seen from driving around the town of Cedarburg and Jackson, there is a lot of standing water. We would need hip waders or an amphibious vehicle (I've heard there is one up in Mercer) to get into those areas. Plus, even the fields that are not flooded but are in low lying areas, the ground is too soft and we may cause more damage than it is worth if we cross those fields. So out of the last three weekends, we have only pulled trails on the first weekend and have struck out on the last two; we are planning on going out this upcoming Saturday (April 14) to try to finish up for the season.

This month, we will be holding elections at the Club Meeting. Next fall, we are looking at donating money for two scholarships to be made available next spring at Cedarburg and Grafton's High Schools. We will discuss this more in the fall to work out the details.

Now it is on to our next season within a season – our fund raising season with the county fair. And it is our 40^{th} year we have had a tent at the fair. So mark your calendars for August 1 thru August 5 for this summer's Ozaukee County Fair. Our calling committee will be calling in late May or early June for volunteers to work in our kitchen or behind the bar.

Till next month, keep your track in the snow and I'll see you on the trails.
