TRAIL WORK

At this point, we are very close to finishing up our trail system. We have the snow fence to put up along Granville Road, finish marking a short section of trail that connects up to the Germantown trail, and check a few spots because the cold, warm, cold temperatures have not been kind to us. The frost has pushed our signs up out of the ground and then the warm and soft ground has allowed our trail signs to fall over. Once it gets cold and stays cold, we should be set.

So if you are reading this newsletter before the weekend, Saturday, December 8 is our last scheduled morning to work on trails. If you can help, stop out at the Kison Farm around 7:30am.

SNO-PHONES

We're getting these out early so you have them once it starts to snow. To open our trails, we need to have at least 6" of snow and the temperature has been below 32 degrees Fahrenheit for a spell to get the ground and water holes to freeze. SNO-FARIs

So far, we have two trips planned and the first one will take place on February 1st thru 3rd, 2013. Chris Bumpke is heading up this trip and we'll be staying at the AmericInn in Silver City, Michigan. Initally, there were ten (10) rooms blocked off under Monticello (seven (7) with queen beds and three (3) with king beds) and the rate is \$80 per night plus tax (you need to mention Monticello when reserving your room to get this rate; otherwise it is \$103 per night). If you plan to get there a day or two early or even stay a day or two later, let them know and you'll still get that \$80 rate per night.
