LANDOWNERS



TRAIL WORK

As you have seen last month, we have listed our trail work dates for this fall. Depending on how the fields are with crops, we'd like to get as much in before deer hunting starts, so please mark your calendars with the dates listed further down on this page. We need all the help possible to get all done in a short time frame.

Also, we do need to build a bridge over a wide drainage ditch just east of Granville Road. We have all the necessary materials except one 32' telephone pole; we are planning to get this in and done on the Saturday, November 4, given this area stays dry in order for us to get back there safely. Please keep this date on your calendar as we will need a good crew to get this all in place and constructed. More updates on this project as the date gets closer!

Our Arrowhead drag has gotten a new pan welded onto it and a few other items fixed during the month of September. Thanks goes out to John Henning, Brad Largin and Matt Geszvain for their work on this project.

John Henning has had it by his shop over the last month or so in order to replace the packing pan

located at the rear portion as well as weld up other weak points on the frame. The guys have gone thru most of the structure and by the time you receive this newsletter, our drag should be enroute or at the Kison Farm.

Once it is there, we will need some help wiring up the new lights for the drag; this will help illuminate it on our trails and when crossing the roadways. Anyone handy with DC wiring and lighting, please give Randy Kison a call so we can get this done before the white stuff flies!
