## OZAUKEE COUNTY FAIR IS NEXT...

It is now mid-July and this only means that the Ozaukee County Fair is just two weeks away! Can't believe it is mid-summer; time never slows down, does it... Dates for this summer's Fair are Wednesday, July 31 thru Sunday, August 4<sup>th</sup>. Set up will take place on Monday, July 29 and Tuesday, July 30 starting at 6pm (or earlier); teardown will start around 7pm on Sunday, August 4 (depending on the crowd) and Monday, August 5 for the teardown and cleaning of our cookshack.

As you all know, our food and beverage tent is our one and only fundraiser for the year for our Club. This helps us cover twelve month's of payments on our Tucker loan as well as allowing us to cover expenses relating to snowmobiling and the functions of our Club. Since we are 100% volunteer based, we need all the help we can get; see more on the Fair and our work schedule on the back of this newsletter.

Our tent will be located in the same spot as it was at last summer's Fair, on the north end of the grounds across from the new Curling/Multi-use building. The vehicles from 5 Corners Truck and Auto and 5 Corners Dodge Chrysler Jeep Ram Trucks will be on the south end of our tent. The recreational vehicles from Cedar Creek Motor Sports should be on the east or north side of our tent, depending on tent location. Plus, this is subject to change once we arrive at the grounds on Monday, July 29 for set-up.

Once again, we will have live bands playing nightly Wednesday thru Saturday in our tent. Our own Nesco Queen has gotten local establishments to help sponsor the live bands. They are as follows: The Roadhouse at 5 Corners, D&S on Mainstreet in Kirchhayn, The Bridge Inn in Grafton, Maxwells in Cedarburg and the Railroad Station in Saukville. If you happen to stop at these places, thank them for helping us out this summer.

For those tending bar, the legal drinking age is of Today's Date, 1992. No ID, no alcohol; plus, we are only accepting Wisconsin IDs. Plain and simple and this has keep things working smoothly behind the bar.

All workers, we do ask that you arrive at least 15 minutes before you are scheduled to work so you can review any changes as well as refresh yourself with our procedures. Food pricing for the most part have been held in check, yet beer pricing has gone up due to increases past on to us. This year, 12oz. cans as well as cups of beer are \$4 each and pitchers are \$13 new and \$12 refills. The other alcohol beverages (wine coolers and hard lemonade) are now \$5 each.

Thank you in advance for volunteering your time again this summer. Our tent is 100% volunteer, and this is something that makes us proud. Lets have a good time and raise money to support our Club for the next season. So, till next month, keep your track on the snow or grass or trailer and remember, "United We Trail, Divided We Fail".....
