#### TRAIL REMOVAL

As our weather has gotten better, yet still a little soggy, we are good to go to pull trails. I have thought about the "stay home" deal, yet since we cross farm land and farmers are considered essential and need to work, then we are considered essential due to our obligation to pull trails before our landowners start to use their land. So keep the group to three (3) members and keep your distance in order to comply with the health warnings and guidelines. Plus enjoy being outside!!

#### TRAIL SIGN INVENTORY

As many of you saw in the email blast that went out last weekend, we need your help taking inventory of how many of each sign goes into marking our trails. This is a one-time task that we need to do this spring. Dennis Guttmann has divided our trails into 23 sections and has 23 sheets labeled for each section in a black folder marked "TRAIL AREA SHEETS" in the sign shed at the Kison Farm.

Just to re-itterate our procedure, here it is:

- Each sheet shows pictures of the signs used, count each sign as you remove it, put hash marks to record the quantity of each: IIII = four (4), then put slash  $\$  thru for five (5).

- When that section is complete, put that completed sheet into the green folder "COMPLETED TRAIL AREA OUT SHEETS".

- If you don't complete a section, put a note on the bottom stating "Not complete from tree line to road due to water" or "Not complete past tree line" and then put sheet back into black folder. Moving forward, this will aid us each fall when we are installing trails as you will know how many of each sign to take with you instead of our educated guesses.

This will be interesting to see how many signs we actually use to mark our entire trail system. We know there are a ton of stakes, yet what is the actual count? So if all trail removal is done using our inventory sheets, we should have a very good count! Thank you in advance for your help with our inventory project!

At May's Club meeting, we will need to vote for no more than three (3) of the five (5) members nominated at our March Club meeting. Right now, the three (3) existing Board members up for reelection have been re-nominated and they are Cal Cummings, Matt Geszvain and Deanna Einwalter.
