Also, we are working on a presentation of the Polaris Trail app and how it works (especially for those not riding Polaris sleds), plus the Grooming Tracking GPS app that is tied into SNARS. This latter app is pretty sweet as it shows you where our (or any other groomer has groomed, as long as they have the GPS in their groomer) has groomed yet has a four (4) or five (5) hour delay. You need the delay otherwise you’ll have groomer chasers, which bites as you’ll catch our groomer as it is a lot slower than your sled!!

TRAIL WORK

Matt and crew were out working last weekend and got most of the old Cedar Creek section marked. They have a stretch from Western to Bridge to complete. His crew also marked the trails to Kwik Trip (I keep wanting to type PDQ!!).

Once the ground freezes, we need to go from Granville to Lizbeth and brush as there are a few trees and many branches down, yet they are in water at this time. Then we will tackle the section west of Circle B as we have worked a way thru the industrial park.

As for Randy's section, we have to move a portion of trail along Sherman due to the developer of the old Jim Wiechert farm. We need to see if we are able to move the trail from the south side of Sherman to the north side. As for the rest, there is a few areas that need to be marked.
