UPDATE ON THE TUCKER by Dennis Guttman



Hello club members, hope everybody is having a safe and fun summer as well as being able to navigate around the road construction projects to get to your summer activities.

Wanted to give an update on our Tucker, the Tucker was taken to Ziebell Truck Painting March 24th and we were able to get 2 new engine cover doors, Lee Ziebell has been in contact with me and advised me they gutted the interior of the Tucker as they had to cut a good portion of both rear cab corners out due to rust. We were also able to purchase 2 snow fenders that are attached to the cab doors to help with snow dust from the tracks getting on the mirrors and side window.

As of June 28th the full cab, doors and engine cover and doors have been painted. On July 12th Lee sent me pictures of the sand blasted frame, rear frame/hitch area and rear rack, pictures show that Ziebell rapped up all the tracks as well as all the track idler wheel and carriage assembly so they wouldn't get damaged during the prep and painting process. A second set of pictures showed the all of those areas painted as well as the front plow. We should have it back in time to have Bob Deenow put our new decals on, the decals will be done by July 15th.

I will try to put a photo array together to show the body work progress and somehow display with Tucker at the fair.
