County representation at the Ozaukee AWSC meetings is important to help resolve these issues and discuss other snowmobile trail related topics. Request them to contact Andrew Struck, the Planning and Parks Director, to encourage him to send a county representative to the monthly Ozaukee AWSC meetings, so that these issues can be discussed and corrected.
