TRAILS

At September's Club meeting, a trail issue was brought to our attention by John H. and Mike D. in regards to our trail and the roundabout at Hwy 33 & Hwy I. Issue at hand was where would our trail be routed this season due to the construction? The next day, Matt G. reached out to Keith M. (one of our members plus works for the DOT and is working on this project) to discuss our trail and how we could get thru this area safely. After some discussion plus reviewing the area, Keith M. and his group came up with a cost effective solution that will allow snowmobilers to safely ride thru this area while maintaining the integrity that the DOT requires. Thanks again to John and Mike for letting us know of an issue and to Keith and the DOT for working on a solution!!

Just so you know, we'll start off trailwork by installing the stop signs at the major road crossings (need in by October 15th) followed by brushing, trail markers installation and then cultimulching (if needed).

Trailwork Saturdays start at 7:30am at the Kison Farm and we'll usually work until noon:
