Also, we do realize that everyone's schedule does change and mostly at the last minute; if you have signed up to work yet you will be late or cannot work, please touch base with Chris in order to get coverage for your spot.

Other items for the Fair is repair to the roof of our cookshak above the grills. I do not know the progress, yet the goal was to replace the sheetmetal and seal it up so it would not leak in the event it rains! There maybe more on this later in this newsletter.

Lastly before the ink in my pen runs dry, our Board has made updates to our By-Laws and we will be voting on them at September and October's Club Meetings.
