Club Dues Increase

Due to a statewide decision by the AWSC board, Monticello Sno-Mobile Club dues will increase by \$5 for the 2025/2026 snowmobile season. Active Member dues will now be \$30, and Non-Active Member dues will be \$45. Please note, dues received after December 1 will incur a \$5 late fee. This adjustment helps address rising operational costs for snowmobile clubs across Wisconsin.

Submitting your dues early reduces administrative fees for the club. Thank you for your understanding and prompt payment as we prepare for another great season.
