Trail Opening Considerations

This snow sure is a teaser but we still have a couple deer hunts in the state. December 15 is when the insurance goes on the trail system but the clubs or county alliances determine when the trails are safe and can open. With that being said there are 2 deer hunting season in December, there is an antlerless hunt Dec.11-14 statewide and the antlerless only holiday hunt December 24 2025 -January 1 2026 mainly in the southern portion of the state which includes our trail area. If we have snow and trails are ready to open we have to check with the landowner if we can go across there property or not because they are deer hunting, have to keep the landowners happy. Keep the snow dance going and hopefully we can get our trails open in December.

Trail Updates

At this time, the trails are 95% done. Special thanks to Ken for all his extra work. We will be putting the tracks on the ATV and checking the trail system for down trees. We will remove what we can and plan on finishing on Saturday, December 6th. If you're able to help, it would be appreciated.
